

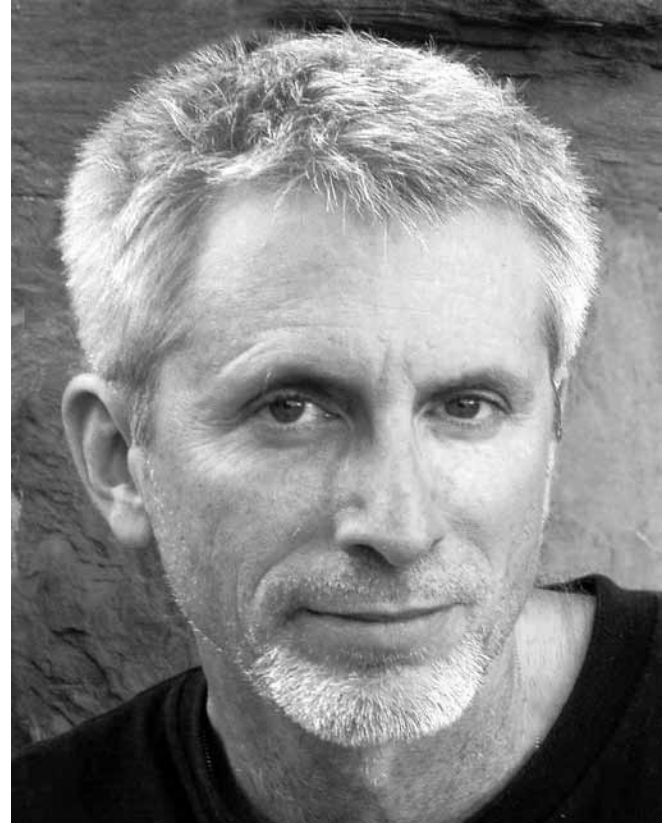
# MICHAEL STILLWATER

Michael Stillwater uses music for healing. An author, educator, award-winning songwriter and recording artist, his music spans genres and defies classification while weaving personal insights with universal principles. From his experience with terminally ill patients and their families, the acclaimed book and recording, *Graceful Passages: A Companion For Living and Dying* was created to meet the spiritual issues of mortality in a respectful, aesthetic way. For this work he and co-author, Emmy-award winning film composer Gary Malkin, received the Elisabeth Kubler-Ross Award for End of Life Service in 2005.

Artist/Founder of Inner Harmony Music, he is creator of *SongCare*, a personalized therapeutic artistry serving individuals, couples and organizations since 1982, which led to the formation of *Song Without Borders*, *The Honoring* and *CoreSong Connect* in 2008-9. A pioneer in the fields of contemporary chant and intuitive song, he facilitates collaborative artistic programs in schools and spiritual centers.

Co-Founder and Executive Director of the nonprofit resource and program provider Companion Arts, he also directs its *Care for the Journey* practitioner renewal program. An interfaith minister and contemplative retreat leader, Stillwater is an inspiring keynote speaker and performer serving healthcare and faith communities, addressing integrative acceptance, coresong reconnecting and cultivating presence. Married to Swiss contemplative psychologist Doris Laesser Stillwater, he resides in Zurich and tours internationally.
